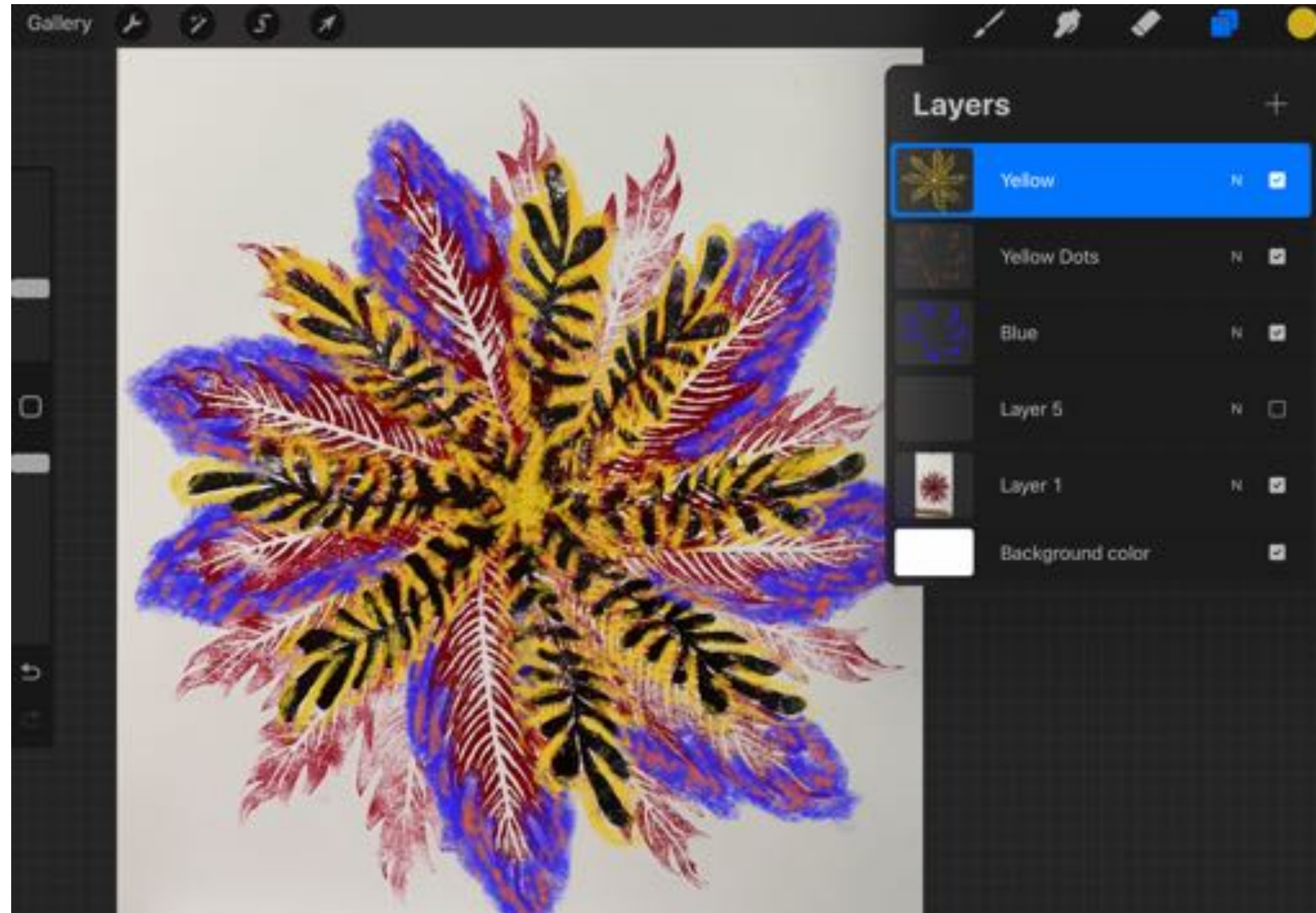

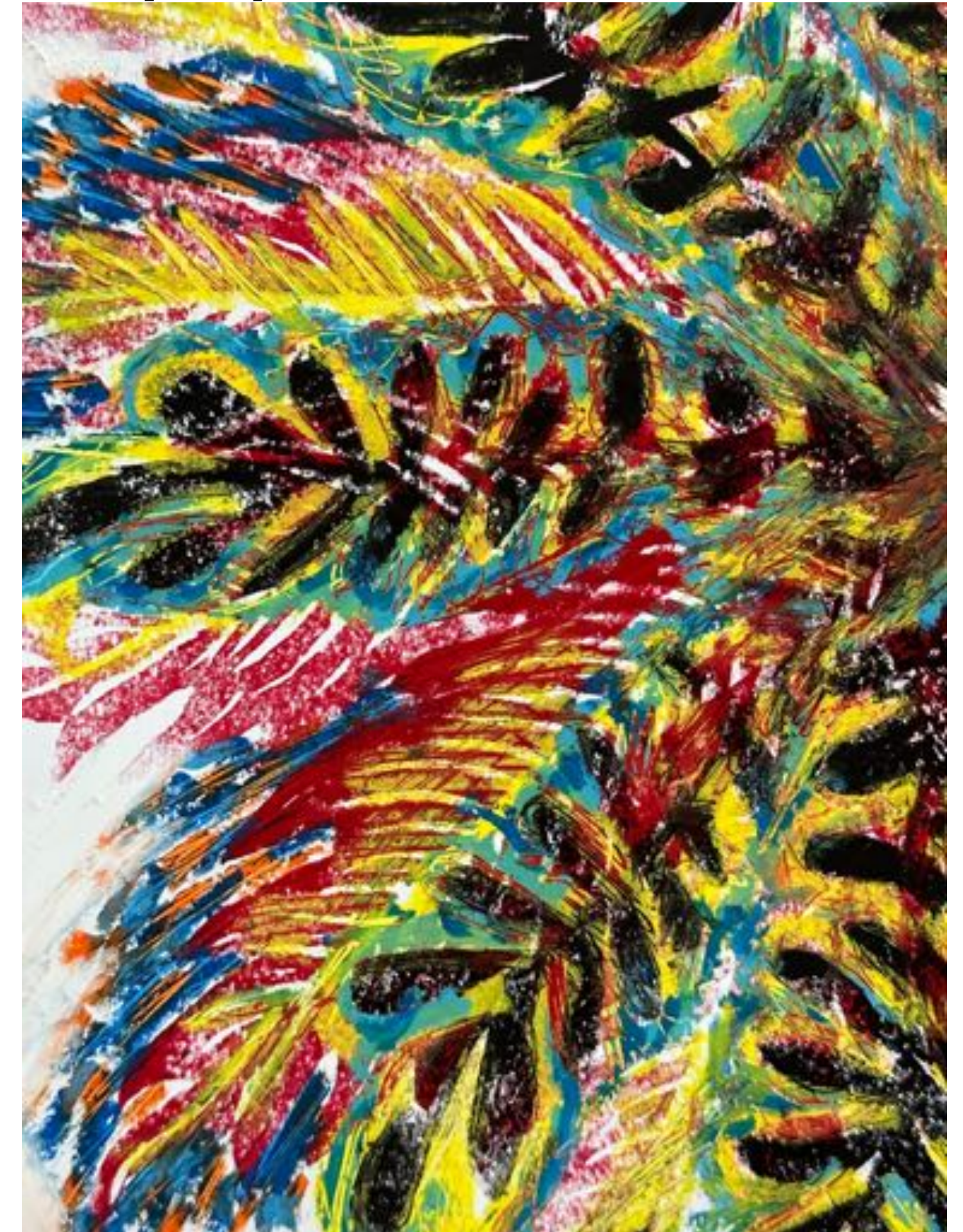

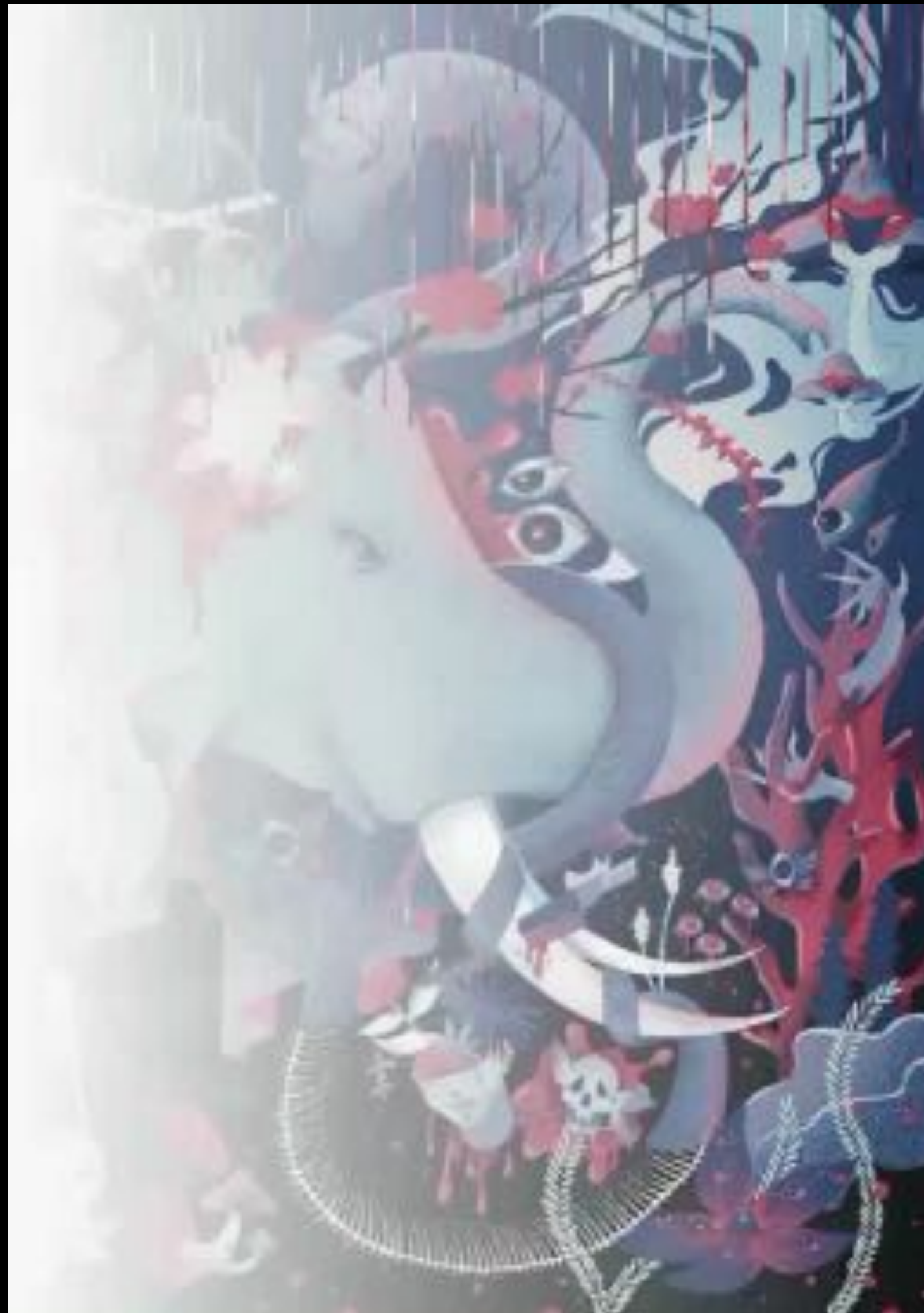
Nicole, Grade 11
